

Privacy Policy

HeathCo LLC (“HC”, “we”, “us”, or “our”), takes your privacy protection very seriously. By using or accessing this website you signify your acknowledgment and assent to the Privacy Policy set forth below, which is hereby incorporated by reference, in its entirety, into our Terms of Use. If you do not agree to this Policy, or any of our Terms of Use, please do not use this website, our products, or our services.

Cookies and Data We Collect

In order to provide you with ease of access to your account, HC will place a cookie (a small text file) on any computer or mobile device from which you access our Website. We collect non-personal-data information that does not permit direct association with any specific individual. We may collect, use, transfer, and disclose non-personal information for any purpose. The following are some examples of non-personal information that we collect:

- We may collect information such as language, zip code, phone number, unique system identifier, location, email and the time zone where the system is used.
- We may also collect information regarding activities on your system, our Website, and our Mobile App.

This information is aggregated and used to provide more useful products to our customers by helping us understand which parts of the System, our Website, and our Mobile App are used, and how they are used. We may also display this information publicly or provide it to others; however, we do not disclose personally-identifying information.

If you send us a support request (for example via a support email or via one of our feedback mechanisms), we reserve the right to publish the non-personally identifiable parts of it in order to help us clarify or respond to your request or to help us support other users.

If we do combine non-personal information with personal information, the combined information will be treated as personal information for as long as it remains combined.

Secure Credit Card Transactions

We protect your credit card information and privacy by using Secure Socket Layer (“SSL”) technology (the industry standard security protocol), hosting our site on secure servers, and maintaining Secure Site status from Autorize.net.

When you provide us with any personal information, such as your credit card number when making a purchase, we use SSL data encryption to restrict access to the data as it is transmitted over the Internet. We use Cookies (small encrypted data files containing references to user ID information that are stored on our secure server and may write to

your hard drive) to keep track of your shopping cart. Your information is safely stored behind a firewall that protects it from users from other networks.

Your Personal Information

To process your order, notify you of matters that may be of interest, and improve your HC shopping experience, we collect information, such as e-mail addresses, domain names, the number of visits each page receives, and other information you may volunteer. Any personal information that you submit to the site will remain as safe and secure as your credit card information. Although we use sophisticated antivirus and encryption technology to protect your personal information, we cannot guarantee the complete security of our servers.

Removal from HeathCo Lists

You may receive periodic emails or postal mailings from us with information on new products and services, or upcoming events. If you do not want to receive e-mail and/ or postal mail from us in the future, please let us know by sending us an email with the subject line "ticket request" to our customer service department at: customerservicesupport@heathcollc.com. **We do not rent or sell your name or other personal information to other companies.**

We may share your personal information with our third party service providers on a need-to-know basis. We engage third party service providers to perform certain services on our behalf. In order to perform those services, the service providers may need to know your personal information. We require that they protect this information and only use it to perform authorized services on our behalf. For example, we may use outside shipping companies, credit card processing companies, resellers, distributors and content providers.

We may share statistical or aggregated non-personal information about our users with advertisers, business partners, sponsors and other third parties. This data is used to customize our website content and advertising to deliver a better experience to our users.

Special Cases

We reserve the right to disclose user information in special cases, when we have reason to believe that disclosing this information is necessary to identify, contact or bring legal action against someone who may be causing injury to or interference with (either intentionally or unintentionally) our rights or property, other HC website users or anyone else that could be harmed by such activities. We may disclose personal information without notice to you in response to a subpoena or when we believe in good faith that the law requires it, to respond to an emergency situation, or when permitted by our Terms of Use.

Policies for Children

We neither knowingly collect nor solicit personal information from anyone under the age of 18, nor do we knowingly allow such persons to register for our Services (as defined in our Terms of Use).
